Grass-leaf Hakea

Outstanding upright shrub with long, narrow, stiff leaves and spikes of vivid pink flowers. Dry or moist soils. Grow with other plants. Susceptible to *Phytophthora* root rot.

Yellow Hakea

Vigorous, erect shrub with prickly needle foliage and axillary, fragrant, yellow flowers. Attractive fruits. Accepts poorer drainage than most hakeas.

Sea-urchin Hakea

Shrub with rounded, grey-green leaves. The cream buds open to pink and cream, sea urchin flowers, which age to maroon and cream. Protect from frost when young. Prune lightly.

Willow-leaved Hakea

Fast growing, dense shrub with long, elliptic, dark green leaves and white flowers. For most soils, even boggy. Suits most aspects. Responds to pruning.

Royal Hakea

Sparsely branched shrub with large, spectacular, rounded, prickly leaves with yellow and green new growth, maturing to red and green. Small clusters of cream flowers. Light to medium soil. Feature plant. Borderline for ACT frosts.

Native Broom Dogwood

Shrub, often tree-like in form, with pendulous, leafless branches and profuse, yellow and red pea flowers. For most soils.

White Kunzea Poverty Bush

Variable shrub with narrow leaves and fluffy, fragrant, white or pink flowers in crowded clusters along stems. Most soils. Attracts insects.

Open, spreading shrub with small, oblong leaves and bright red brush flowers. Dry or moist soils. Needs some overhead protection in Canberra. Spectacular.
