**Form:** prostrate

Rounded shrub with green, divided, prickly foliage and masses of cream flowers. Most acidic or slightly alkaline soils. Bird refuge.

Spreading shrub with small, narrow leaves, pink new growth and red flowers.  
**Syn.** *Grevillea victoriae* var. *tenuinervis*

Pine-leaf Grevillea

Shrub with pointed, linear leaves and profuse, pendent clusters of red flowers. Adapts to most soils in a warm spot. Frost protect when young.  
**Form:** prostrate  
**Syn.** *Grevillea thelemanniana* subsp. *pinaster*

Fan Grevillea

Shrub with deeply divided, prickly, fan shaped leaves and sweetly scented, cream flowers. For acidic to neutral, sandy, gravelly or heavy loam soils. Prune from an early age.

Dense, variable shrub with light green, lobed leaves and red flowers in hanging clusters. Acidic to neutral soils. Quick growing.
