

Wednesday Walk on Little Black Mountain from Frith Road – 5 September 2012

We started the walk from Frith Road and did a circuit of Little Black Mountain with a short detour to the saddle. We were very pleased to have Jean Egan and Tony Wood with us and they showed us some lovely orchids flowering - *Pterostylis nutans*, *Bunochilus umbrinus*, *Cyanicula caerulea*, *Cyrtostylis reniformis* and *Petalochilus fuscatus*. There were also some very good floral displays of other plants - masses of *Acacia genistifolia*, *A. buxifolia*, *A. gunnii*, *Pimelea linifolia*, *Pomaderris intermedia*, *Leucopogon attenuatus*, *L. fletcheri* ssp. *brevisepalus*, *L. virgatus*, *Hovea heterophylla*, *Hardenbergia violacea*, *Phyllanthus hirtellus*, a few *Dillwynia phyllicoides*, *Coronidium oxylepis* ssp. *lanatum*, *Xerochrysum viscosum*, *Stylidium graminifolium*, *Hibbertia obtusifolia*, *Clematis microphylla* and a few flowers on *Grevillea* sp. aka *G. alpina*.
