

Wednesday Walk – Bungonia Road Roadside Stops and The Pomaderris Reserve – 8 October 2014

We travelled to the Bungonia Road (really Mountain Ash Road which is between Goulburn and Bungonia) from Bungendore, via Tarago. We made a couple of roadside stops to view the as yet un-named pomaderris species which we call *Pomaderris* sp. Bungonia. It was flowering well under a powerline easement. There was also a small population where we stopped for morning tea. Also flowering there were *Podolobium ilicifolium*, *Daviesia leptophylla*, *Olearia microphylla*, *Diuris pardina*, *Rhytidosporum procumbens*, *Pultenaea subspicata* and the prostrate form of *P. microphylla*. We then returned to The Pomaderris Reserve which was created recently to protect *Pomaderris delicata*. Unfortunately, we didn't find any *P. delicata* inside the Reserve but finally found a couple of plants flowering on the roadside. Quite a lot of things were flowering including *Lissanthe strigosa*, *Coronidium scorpioides*, *Patersonia sericea*, *Diuris pardina*, *D. chryseopsis*, *Stypandra glauca*, *Dillwynia sericea*, *D. sieberi*, *Pomaderris* sp.
