

## Wednesday Walk at Tinker's Creek Travelling Stock Reserve – 19 November 2008

Tinker's Creek Travelling Stock Reserve is on Mountain Creek Road, not far from Canberra. It is 6 ha and has Tinker's Creek running through it. It was our first visit and we were surprised at its diversity. It is open forest with a good understorey. Flowering highlights were *Dichopogon fimbriatus*, *Cheiranthra cyanea* and *Cassinia longifolia*. Other interesting plants were *Acacia melanoxylon*, *A. falciformis*, *Pomaderris eriocephala*, *P. angustifolia* and 3 species of carex – *C. appressa*, *C. incomitata*, *C. fascicularis*.
